- \$3 buys one County Connection ticket for a child attending an after-school program.
- \$5 will allow a student with a disability to attend a career exploration tour, including lunch.
- \$5 will provide a hot and healthy meal delivered to a home-bound senior.
- \$10 will provide two easy-reading books for a child learning to read.
- \$10 will provide an hour of meaningful activities and care to someone with Alzheimer’s.
- \$20 will provide a local teen with one day in an after-school program.
- \$20 will allow a disadvantaged child to experience the joy of a baseball game with friends.
- \$20 will supply a new life jacket to keep a child safe while boating at camp.
- \$20 provides a gas card for a single mom to get to work.
- \$20 pays for materials for an elementary classroom to learn about inclusion of people with disabilities.
- \$25 buys a warm coat and mittens for a child in need.
- \$25 will provide after-hours emergency notification to a community member serving in the military.
- \$30 provides one hour of smoking cessation counseling.
- \$35 will provide a scholarship for a preschooler to attend Safety Town.
- \$35 will provide a basic layette kit to a low-income family of a newborn baby.
- \$35 provides a support kit for a recently diagnosed breast cancer patient.
- \$40 provides tax services for both state and federal returns for a disabled person.
- \$50 will buy new shoes, underwear, socks and a backpack for a young child starting school.
- \$50 provides a crisis response support person for a rape victim during an exam.
- \$50 provides a healthy after school snack for one Teaming Up with YOUth site.
- \$50 will purchase work boots to enable a person to go to work everyday.
- \$50 will pay for a group therapy session for someone struggling with drugs and alcohol.
- \$50 will go toward the cost of life-sustaining oxygen for someone with no insurance coverage.
- \$75 will pay for a counseling session for a depressed senior.
- \$75 will provide one brand new bunk mattress so campers can enjoy a comfortable night’s sleep.
- \$75 will send a child who has lost a loved one to a children’s grief camp.
- \$100 provides public transportation for one month for a disabled person to get to work.
- \$100 provides 30 children with one day in an after-school program.
- \$100 provides program support for one volunteer Scout leader to impact 35 young men for a year.

- \$100 provides 500 pounds of free food delivered to a local agency.
- \$115 will provide emergency groceries for a family that is a victim of a house fire.
- \$150 will support one Boy Scout for an entire year.
- \$200 will offer rent assistance to help a family avoid eviction.
- \$225 provides diapers and wipes for a one-year-old for a year.
- \$280 will send a low income child to overnight camp for a week.
- \$300 will provide a healthy snack for an after-school mentoring program for one year.
- \$500 will help offset the high cost of home heating fuel for a family during the winter months.
